

Our design/build process centers on clear communication and productive collaboration ensuring a seamless journey from concept to completion, resulting in a beautifully crafted, ecologically vital landscape tailored to your vision.

Our Process continued

Design Outside's comprehensive approach combines collaboration and communication with creativity, expertise, and attention to detail, to create a landscape that enhances your outdoor living experience for years to come.

Discovery

Most of our projects begin with an initial discovery call followed by a visit to your property where we discuss your project and find out more about your goals and aspirations for your property.

This is where we get to know each other and decide if we are a good fit.

Site Analysis

Every project begins with a comprehensive site analysis.

- Design Outside team members conduct a thorough examination of existing conditions and site characteristics including topography, environmental constraints, existing vegetation and plant communities, the siting of existing buildings, and solar exposure and prevailing winds.
- We will also look at regulatory constraints and land use regulations which may impact any proposed design interventions.

Schematic Design

During Schematic Design (SD) we develop preliminary design concepts which explore the layout of programmatic elements and present the big ideas which will guide the project throughout the entire process.

- This phase generally unfolds over several meetings as we work with our clients to define the project's direction.
- This phase culminates in a final Master Plan which unites aesthetic, functional, and ecological considerations to create a cohesive vision for your project.

Our Process continued

Design Development

During Design Development (or DD) we create detailed plans, sections and construction details including layout, planting designs, material selections, and amenity specifications. These documents help to define costs, clarify design intent and further align the design with project goals.

- We will also coordinate with any necessary engineering or specialty consultants for specific elements. These may include structural engineers, pool and fountain consultants or lighting designers.
- We will prepare a budgeting estimate to ensure the project scope matches your investment goals.

Construction Documentation

- During the construction document phase we create finalized measured drawings and specifications which communicate every step of the construction process with clarity and precision.
- Detailed timeline and project schedule preparation.
- At the end of construction documentation we present a final construction proposal outlining all costs to build your project.

Construction Implementation

- Our skilled team begins transforming your outdoor space, starting with site prep including demolition, rough grading and clearing of undesirable vegetation.
- Drainage and utility infrastructure is coordinated with the location of other site elements and installed to avoid conflicts and ease of access if needed.
- We carefully install hardscapes and structures, such as patios, walkways, walls, pools and pergolas, followed by planting and finishing touches.
- Additional systems like irrigation and lighting are seamlessly integrated to enhance your experience of your landscape.


Project Management

Nestled in the heart of the waterfront historic district in Warren, the landscape design for this finely detailed arts and crafts style home provides a dynamic outdoor living space for a young and active family to enjoy. The new terraces, walkways and gardens activate the space with lush plantings and multiple outdoor rooms to move through. A thoughful porportioned dining terrace of natural cleft bluestone provides an area to grill and entertain. A casual landing sits on the edge of the garden, providing a place to sit and view passersby and the surrounding historic downtown context.

Project Details

As part of a larger family estate situated along the East Branch of the Westport River, a newly designed home is thoughtfully sited on the edge of a wildflower meadow and oak woodland. Outdoor living spaces are designed to feel like an extension of the interior, allowing for gathering and entertaining while having uninterrupted views into the landscape. A crisp bluestone dining and food prep terrace extends from the kitchen to the southern woodland edge, allowing for evening dining in dappled shade. A meandering collection of reclaimed granite slabs create a simple and direct walkway that slips between the house and the wildflower meadow beyond. A subtle expansion of paving provides a lovely spot to sit and look out at the natural beauty and bounty of native wildflowers, bugs, birds, and bees move throughout the site.

Project Details

A thoughtful renovation to a historic home in South Dartmouth presented a unique opportunity to create a landscape that responds to the character and charm of the home as well as the beauty and topographic features of the site. The site context and arrival sequence of weaving through acres of woodland, vineyards, and remnant stonewalls calls for a landscape design that feels timeless and grounded. The result is a terraced landscape of expertly crafted native fieldstone walls, a natural cleft bluestone terrace, and reclaimed granite steps throughout. Native plantings enclose outdoor living spaces and stepping stone paths throughout the site. The organization of plantings, pathways, and gathering spaces create ample opportunities for entertaining and gathering while feeling connected to the surrounding landscape.

Dennis is passionate about crafting meaningful experiences through landscape design and construction.


